Sheriff Esco R. Jarnagin is committed to protecting the constitutional rights of all the citizens of Hamblen County and to making our community safer to live and raise our families.

Sheriff Esco R. Jarnagin is serving his fourth term as the top law



enforcement officer for Hamblen County. He was born and raised in Hamblen County. He is a graduate of the Hamblen County School System, East Tennessee State University (BS Degree in Criminal Justice), and a graduate of the FBI National Academy where he studied Leadership and Management. Sheriff Jarnagin is a veteran of Foreign Wars and received an Honorable Discharge from military service during the Vietnam War. He has investigated over 6,000 criminal cases and named Lawman of the Year three times.

The Hamblen County Sheriff's Department was established in 1870 and the jail was constructed for less than \$3,000. Our current jail has 255 beds. The population of the county is approaching 63,000 people. The county has a total of 176 square miles of which 15 square miles is water.


The duties of the Sheriff have increased as administrative procedures, Court decisions and requirement of the laws have brought about sophisticated and technical advancements to law enforcement. LETTER

Dear Sheriff, Esco R. Jarnagin, my name is William Eugene Parrott of [REDACTED] [REDACTED]. I'm Joe Parrott's second son. You're an honorable and wise law man and you have special F.B.I. training. I'm hoping with your experience and expertise, maybe you can help me and my family with a huge problem that we have been going through for the past thirty- nine years. Back in 1979 I was targeted by Jimmy Ray Roberts of Knoxville Tn. He was a good friend of gambler Billy Ray Lee of Morristown Tn. Some how Jimmy got a job testing NASA computers for the C.I.A., it's a mind reading device that works from extreme low frequency micro wave technology. [E.L.F.] The same stuff that the Washington Navy ship yard shooter Aaron Alexis complained about before he committed his mass shooting. Esteban Santiago complained of the same thing just before he shot several people at the Hollywood Florida airport. The C.I.A. gave him four of those NASA computers to test on the public to see if it could be used as a weapon. He hired his half brother Gerry Roberts of Corrington Tn. Along with three of his sons, James, Jerold and Curtis and several grandsons as they graduated school along with several other family members, but I don't know their names. I have written my story down as best I can on a blog and I'm sending a copy with this letter to you. I only have an 8<sup>th</sup> grade education and my penmanship isn't the best, I don't think I'll be winning a Pulitzer prize any time soon. Here's a problem I'm also having, I have written two letters to President Donald Trump, one letter to Paulette D Leach, she runs the correctional facility at Ft. Leavenworth Ks. Where Major Nidal Hasan the Ft. Hood shooter is housed, one letter to F.B.I. supervisor Special Agent Karen L. Ferguson of the Nashville office, one letter to F.B.I. Special Agent in charge Troy A. Sowers of the Knoxville office, one letter to Pastor John Hagee of San Antonio Tx, one letter to F.B.I. Special Agent Casey of 2620 Knob Creek Rd. Johnson City Tn., one letter to the Secretary of Homeland Security Kirstjen M. Neilson of Washington DC, one letter to Special Agent JJ Sipos of the T.B.I. of Knoxville Tn., one letter to Dibble & Miller. law firm of Rochester N.Y., one letter to Tennessee Congressman John Duncan of Washington DC., one letter to F.B.I. director Robert Muller of Washington DC, one letter to Tennessee Senator Lamar Alexander of Washington DC, one letter to Hawkins County Sheriff Ronnie Lawson of Rogersville Tn., two letters to Tennessee Attorney General Herbert H. Slatery III of Nashville Tn., one letter to F.B.I. Director Christopher A. Wray of Washington DC, one letter to Sean Hannity of Fox news of New York NY., two letters to the 84<sup>th</sup> Attorney General of the

United States Jeff Sessions of Washington DC., and one letter to the First Lady of The United States Melania Trump of Washington DC. And the only person I've heard back from is T.B.I. Special Agent JJ Sipos, he called me on the phone and said that he couldn't help me because the F.B.I. has jurisdiction. I'm not the smartest person on this planet but it's clear to me that there is a cover up going on here. I have my work history for the past twelve years that shows the places and dates that I have picked up loads from and delivered to across the United State. I have run over one point four million miles for Big G Express out of Shelbyville Tn. I have been a long-haul tractor trailer driver since 1982 and I have driven over four million miles total in my trucking career. C.I.A. contractors are like all contractors, they must save all their credit card, hotel, fuel, phone and food receipts to collect off their Federal income tax every quarter to recover their out of pocket money, and Verizon should have a record of most of their calls and locations that can be cross referenced with my work history sheets. I'm going to put a copy of it in my package to you. Is there anything or anyone that you can think of that possibly will help my family and me get justice for this inhumane mind control crime that has been committed against us? I have burned several cd's from you tube of other targeted individuals' stories that I'm sending too so you can watch them on your computer and see how big the targeting has gotten since the program started back in 1973. Do you remember that Trailways bus crash that happened back in 1973 with a tractor trailer on highway 11w near Bean Station? Jimmy told me that that was one of his first crashes he caused with a NASA computer and for several years since then he and his family gave highway 11w the nickname bloody 11w. from all the men, woman and children that they killed in automobile crashes on that highway. The Roberts family can cause heart attacks with that device especially if the victim has a pace maker. They are responsible for several hundred deaths that most people don't know about. If you would, I would feel Blessed if you would write me back with your thoughts on this matter.
